White Wines

6. Boschendal Grand Cuvee Sauvignon Blanc - South Africa **£28**

These complex flavours carry through to the creamy, Harmonious palate adding to the mineral zesty finish.

7. Macon Lugny Les Genivres Louis Latour - France **£29**

The mouth is ample and offers delicious musky flavours with a beautiful intensity and finish.

8. Moko Black Sauvignon Blanc - New Zealand **£29**

Hints of gooseberry rolling into a full layered palate, finishing with a lovely balance of texture weight and clean refreshing finish.

9. Franschoek. La Cotte Chenin Blanc - South Africa **£28**

The mouth watering acidity makes a good addition to the slightly sweet tropical fruits on the palate. It also gives the wine a refreshingly crisp finish.

10. Simonnet-Febvre Chablis - France **£30**

The rich and complex nose is characterized by pleasant and subtle floral and mineral aromas. It has a wonderful structure in the mouth with minerality and a charming chardonnay-typical aroma.

11. Marqués de Cáceres Verdejo – Spain **£27**

Hints of grapefruit can be savoured, along with citrus, crisp green fruits and notes of hibiscus. The Verdejo has a long finish and is very refreshing with medium acidity.

White Wines continued

12. Pacheca White - Portugal £27
Golden yellow colour, fresh and elegant.

13. Trapiche Pinot Grigio - Mendoza Argentina £26
Aromas of citrus fruit and green apples follow through to soft flavours of lemon and melon with a crisp, dry finish.

Red Wines

14. Boschendal Merlot - South Africa £28
An elegant cool climate style of wine, with intensity of fruit. Good natural balance between primary fruit aromas.

15. Montepulciano - Italy £26
This classic ruby red wine is medium bodied and juicy. This wine pairs best with pasta, pork and poultry dishes.

16. Boschendal Shiraz - South Africa £28
Generous red fruit with hints of cassis and pepper on the nose, concentrated, fleshy plum, well integrated white pepper, oak and spice succulent fruity finish.

17. Dom Martinho, Quinto Do Carmo - Portugal £28
Great blend from Portugal, nice easy drinking.

Red Wines continued

18. Casillero Del Diablo Cabernet Sauvignon – Chile **£26**

A smooth, full bodied Cabernet Sauvignon with notes of cassis and black berries, which are complemented by hints of coffee and dark chocolate.

19. Campo Viejo Rioja - Spain **£27**

Rich aromas have a pronounced intensity with an initial scent of ripe red fruit followed by gentle sweet notes of vanilla and spices.

20. Amarone della Valpolicella Le Vigne - Italy **£38**

This is a wine for enthusiasts and connoisseurs alike. This wine is consistently one of the best to come out of Italy.

21. Pacheca Red - Portugal **£27**

Aromas of black fruit and delicate hints of spice. Intensive red colour and a nose rich in floral notes.

22. Marqués de Cáceres Gran Reserva - Spain **£38**

Deliciously full and complex in the mouth with silky smooth tannins. The character of a unique vintage that is rich and structured, whilst combining the elegance of a splendid wine that promises to develop superbly over the next few years.

23. Caiado - Portugal **£25**

Rich, spicy and well balanced.

Rosé Wines

24. Mateus Rosé - Portugal

£24

Fresh and seductive wine, with fine and intense bouquet, well balanced and tempting wine, brilliantly complemented by a soft and slightly fizzy finish.

25. Sutter Home White Zinfandel - America

£26

A delicate blush pink colour introduces this fresh, lively wine. On the palate, light creaminess surrenders to a refreshing crisp finish of strawberries and melon.

26. Pacheca Rose - Portugal

£25

Beautiful pink colour and very aromatic with notes of cherry.

Champagne & Sparkling Wines

27. Laurent Perrier Brut - France

£49

Deliciously fresh and elegant Champagne, with great balance of fruity flavours and creamy texture. A signature celebration fizz.

28. Laurent Perrier Rose - France

£95

Wine of France, in its elegant bottle of late 16th century inspiration, this rosé champagne is memorable for its freshness and unique aromas of fresh-picked red berries.

29. Prosecco - Italy

£23

A lively bright pale wine with fragrant and refined palate with hints of ripe apples.
